

ORDINANCE 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73, BICYCLES, UNICYCLES, THREE-WHEELED CYCLES AND GOLF CARTS, OF TITLE VII OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA CITY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Common Council of Columbia City, Indiana, pursuant to Indiana Code § 9-21 et seq. has found that golf carts operated within the jurisdictional limits of the City of Columbia City should be regulated; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Columbia City has deemed it in the City's best interests of its citizens to amend Chapter 73 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Columbia City, Indiana as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 73.41 is hereby amended in its entirety to state the following:


“Golf Carts” shall be defined by I.C. 9-13-2-69.7, and as updated by any subsequent code amendment/revision, and be equipped with factory seating for all occupants with a maximum occupancy of six (6) people and with a maximum of two (2) persons per seat. Unless the laws of the State of Indiana state otherwise, no one under the age of six (6) shall be allowed to ride in a golf cart and no one under ten (10) years of age shall be allowed on the back seat of the cart. The golf cart driver shall be solely responsible for his or her decision-making as to the safety of his or her passengers. All passengers must be seated while the golf cart is in use. Golf carts shall not be altered in any way to be in violation of state law or this subchapter or used to pull, push, tow, attach or drag any trailer, cart, seating apparatus, sidecar or any other accessory.

Section 2. If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance in which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.


Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Columbia City, Indiana.






